



### **Official Rules, Seattle Center KEXP Concerts at the Mural Series: VIP Contest**

PARTICIPATION IS FREE; NO PURCHASE NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN.

- 1) Eligibility: The Seattle Center VIP Contest is open to legal residents of the United States and the District of Columbia who are 18 years of age or older at time of entry. Employees, directors (and their immediate families and those living in their same household) of Seattle Center are not eligible to participate or win. Void where prohibited by law. The contest is subject to all applicable federal, state and local laws and regulations.
- 2) How to Enter: The Contest begins at 12:01 A.M. (PST) on July 22, 2011 and ends at 11:59 P.M. (PST) on August 12, 2011. To enter, respond to Seattle Center Foundation posts on Twitter, each Friday between July 22, 2011 and August 12, 2011 a clue or key word will be posted on Twitter, participants need only retweet the specified key word or clue given on that day to be qualified for the drawing. Seattle Center, the City of Seattle, Cosponsors, Administrator, and their respective parents, affiliates, divisions, and agencies and each of the foregoing entities' respective employees, officers, directors, and agents are not responsible for incorrect or inaccurate receipt or transfer of entry information due to any cause, including but not limited to human error, technical malfunctions, lost/delayed data receipt, failures of any telephone network, computer equipment, or software or any combination thereof, inability to access web sites, damage to a user's computer system (hardware and software), or for late, lost, incomplete, stolen, misdirected, mechanically reproduced, illegible, or incorrectly entered entries. Participants who submit inaccurate or incomplete entry data may be excluded from participation in the prize drawing. All entries become the property of Seattle Center, a Department of the City of Seattle. Entries will not be used by the Seattle Center for commercial purposes, but are subject to disclosure under the Washington Public Records Act. Entrants agree to be bound by these rules and consent to use of their names in any and all media without further consideration.
- 3) Prize Drawing. On each Friday between July 22, 2011 and August 12, 2011, a random drawing will be conducted from among all eligible entries to select potential Prize winners. The drawing will be conducted by the Seattle Center Director or designee. Potential winners are subject to eligibility verification and compliance with these official rules. Seattle Center will notify the potential winners by regular mail, email, or telephone within five (5) days of the prize drawing. Potential winners will be required to authorize an affidavit of eligibility/release of liability within seven (7) days of issuance of notification. Failure to complete and return/transmit the authorization in the time noted, or if prize notification is undeliverable, will result in disqualification and an alternate winner will be selected and notified. Prize winners must be 18 years of age or older. Odds of winning prize are subject to the total number of eligible entries received.
- 4) Prize Packages: Each week one lucky winner will win VIP seating at an upcoming KEXP Concerts at the Mural series which include six (6) Next Fifty folding chairs within a designated VIP section, six (6) food tickets, and six (6) drink tickets (only valid for those 21 and over in designated area). Parking/transportation accommodations will not be included.
- 5) Limitations of Liability: Each participant agrees (i) to abide by the terms of these Official Rules and the decisions of Seattle Center which are final and binding on all matters relating to this Contest, and (ii) to release, discharge, indemnify and hold harmless Seattle Center, the City of Seattle and Co-Sponsors from any & all claims, actions, and/or liability for any injuries, loss or damage of any kind arising from or in connection with participation in and/or for entry into the Seattle Center Contest, any related activities, or acceptance or use of any prize won.
- 6) General Conditions: If for any reason this Contest is not capable of running as planned due to infection by computer virus, bugs, tampering, unauthorized intervention, fraud, technical failures, or any other causes beyond the control of the Seattle Center, which corrupt or affect the administration, security, fairness, integrity or proper conduct of this Hunt, Seattle Center, the City of Seattle and the Co-Sponsors (Prize donors and SCF) reserve the right, at their sole discretion, to disqualify any individual who tampers with the entry process, and to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the Contest. Should this Contest be terminated, Seattle Center, the City of Seattle and Co-Sponsors reserve the right to select potential winner in a random drawing from among all eligible, non-suspect entries received as of the action requiring such termination. Released Parties are not responsible for any problems or technical malfunction of any computer system, server, or service providers, computer equipment, software, failure of any entry to be received by Seattle Center, the City of Seattle and Co-Sponsors on account of technical problems, human error or any combination thereof, including any injury or damage to participant's or any other person's computer equipment relating to or resulting from participation in this Contest. In the event of a dispute as to who submitted an online entry, the entry will be deemed submitted by the authorized account holder of the email address

submitted at the time of entry. "Authorized account holder" is defined as the person assigned to an email address by an Internet access provider, online service provider or other organization responsible for assigning email addresses for the domain associated with the email address in question.

17) Winners List: Each week a winner will be chosen and notified of their prize. In the event that a winner does not qualify, a new winner will be chosen at random and notified.
